Works notification: Setting up site at Werribee Street

We're removing the Werribee Street level crossing to improve safety, provide more consistent travel times and improve connections between the north and south sides of the train line.

We're continuing to set up our site, with construction set to begin in the coming months. This will ensure a safe and efficient work environment is created for our workers and the local community.

Throughout April, we:

- Investigated ground conditions around the level crossing and within the rail corridor
- Began site clearing to make way for works
- Conducted track maintenance works

Upcoming works

Throughout May, we'll:

- Set up our main site compounds along the rail line with site offices, staff car parking and space to store construction materials and equipment
- Install fencing and safety barriers around the project area
- Locate and relocate underground services, including electricity, gas and water
- Install conduits and pits for the signalling systems
- Make changes to Princes Highway and Werribee Street intersection to make room for construction vehicles
- Clear trees and vegetation within the project area and set up fencing to protect trees that won't be removed
- Close public car parking, the pedestrian footpath and routes 190 and 192 bus stop on the south side of Cottrell Street between Greaves and Werribee streets to make room for a temporary track for freight trains

Our general working hours are Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturday between 7am to 3pm. To see where we'll be working and setting up our site, see the map on the other page.

Traffic impacts

During these works, there'll be reduced speeds around the project site, temporary off-peak lane closures and traffic management in place to help guide motorists, pedestrians and cyclists safely through the area.

Night works

We'll work at night in late May between 8pm and 6am to create easier and safer access for construction vehicles, including:

- Removing part of the Princes Highway median where it intersects with Werribee Street
- Altering turning lanes from Princes Highway onto Werribee Street
- Installing safety barriers along the side of the road on Werribee Street, Cottrell Street, Bulban Road and Princes Highway

More information will be provided to residents that may be affected by these works.

Health and safety on site

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority as we begin to deliver the Werribee Street Level Crossing Removal Project, as is supporting social distancing measures in line with current health advice.

We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.

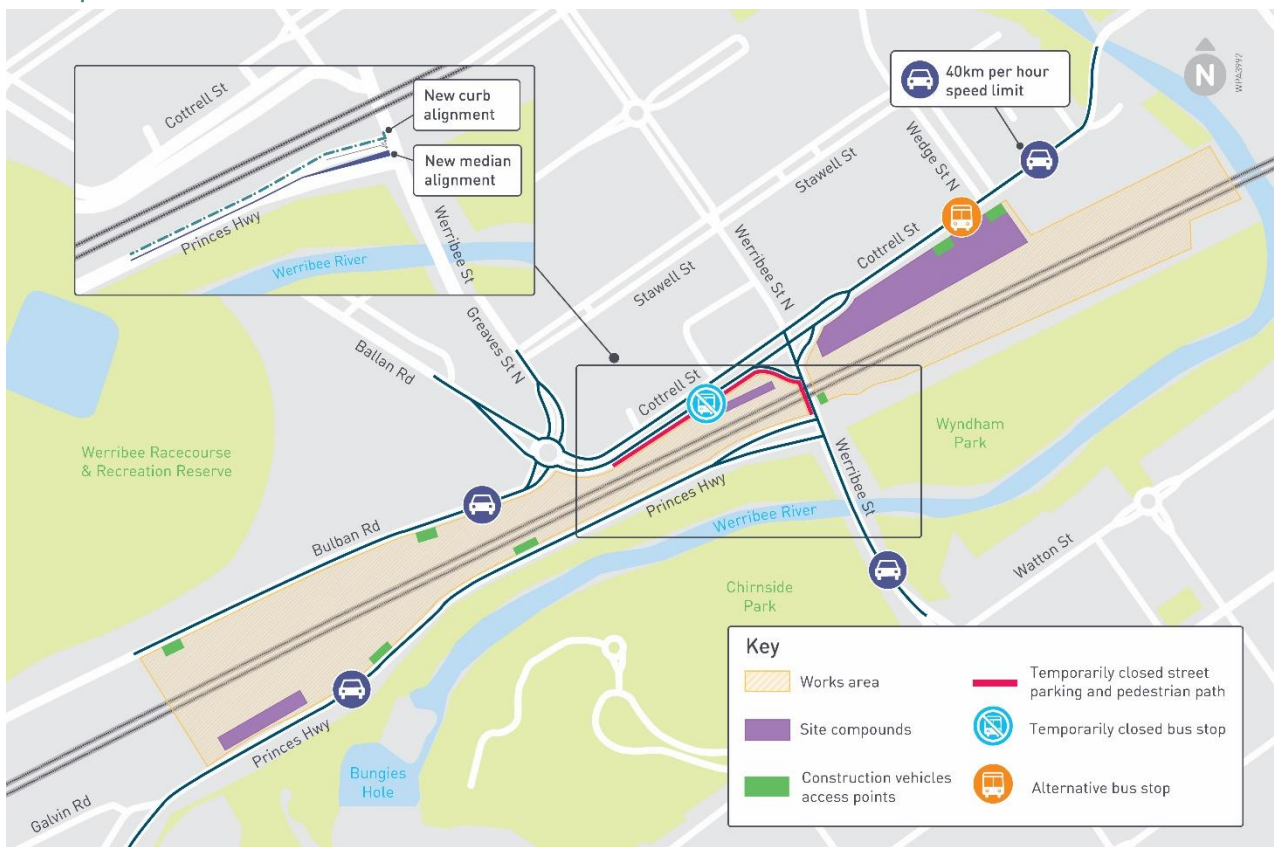
