

# LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL UPDATE

## Road bridge taking shape

We're removing the dangerous and congested level crossing at Cherry Street in Werribee by building a new road bridge, connecting Tarneit Road to Princes Highway.

We're making good progress on site and we'll soon install the beams to create the new road bridge structure across the rail line.

At the Tarneit Road and Railway Avenue, and Princes Highway and Wattle Avenue intersections, works are continuing as we prepare for new traffic signals.

#### Throughout July, we'll:

- Continue relocating the water main next to Jellicoe Street and the Wyndham City Council offices
- Continue to prepare the intersections at Tarneit Road and Railway Avenue, and Princes Highway and Wattle Avenue for traffic signals
- Begin building the concrete structure for the pedestrian underpass
- Install 14 bridge beams, creating the new road bridge structure

During these works, there'll be changes to the way you travel around the area. There'll be temporary offpeak lane closures and reduced speeds along Cherry Street, Railway Avenue, Tarneit Road, and Princes Highway.

We'll have pedestrian detours in place on Railway Avenue and Tarneit Road. Access to Federation Village from Railway Avenue will be left in, left out only until Friday 31 July 2020.

We'll help guide motorists, pedestrians and cyclists safely through the area and there will be traffic management and detour signs will be in place.

#### A new road bridge

We're removing the Cherry Street level crossing by building a road bridge, directly connecting Tarneit Road to Princes Highway.




### Better and safer pedestrian and cycling connections

We'll build a new pedestrian underpass at Cherry Street to provide a safer crossing for pedestrians and cyclists and install a new shared use path to make it easier to get around the area.

## After hours works

To minimise traffic disruptions during the day, the delivery of the bridge beams will be staggered across Friday and Saturday nights.

Seven bridge beams will be delivered to site at midnight on Friday 10 July via Princes Highway and Cherry Street and again at midnight on Saturday 11 July via Railway Avenue.

We'll have traffic management in place at the entry points to our site. We'll stop traffic for approximately 10 minutes to make sure the delivery truck can enter site safely and for the safety of motorists and pedestrians.

From 14 July to 8 August we'll work between 7am and 7pm, and from 8 August to 30 August we'll work day and night in the Southern Rural Water Channel next to Wyndham City Council offices.

During this time, we'll trench the area and lay piping, before we transfer the Southern Rural Water channel into underground pipes.

We'll take every measure to reduce construction impacts, however you may notice some construction related noise and vibration.

At times, heavy vehicles will be required to deliver materials to site after hours via Railway Avenue, Princes Highway and Cherry Street.

## Buses replace trains on the Werribee line

To install the bridge beams safely, we'll need to work while trains aren't running. Buses will replace trains on sections of the Werribee Line from 8.30pm Friday 10 July to Sunday 12 July.


